Measures Taken to make campus ragging free

PREAMBLE.

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of "University of Kerala v/s. Council, Principals, Colleges and others" in SLP no. 24295 of 2006 dated 16.05.2007 and that dated 8.05.2009 in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, and in consideration of the determination of the Central Government and the University Grants Commission to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including, as per the recommendations of **Medical Council of India, New Delhi** based upon directives from **Hon'ble Supreme Court**, which are in turn based on recommendations of **Raghvan Committee**, Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) are required to take appropriate, preventive and corrective steps to make the campus ragging free from the menace of ragging. any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in all the constituents colleges of DMIMS(Deemed to be University) , and thereby, to provide the healthy development, physically and psychologically, of all students, the DMIMS(Deemed to be University) in consultation with deans and administrative authorities of constituent colleges will enforce strict discipline and vigilance.

Measures Taken to Curb the Menace of Ragging & Action Taken Report

As per the recommendations of **Medical Council of India, New Delhi** based upon directives from **Hon'ble Supreme Court**, which are in turn based on recommendations of **Raghvan Committee**, Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) and per university objective to make the campus ragging free with zero tolerance are required to take appropriate, preventive and corrective steps to make the campus ragging free from the menace of ragging. Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College a constituent college of Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University) has also taken steps in that direction as stated below:

1. **Sensitization of the faculty members:** In view of increasing the level of awareness of the members of faculty including heads of Department, Anti ragging committee and Anti ragging Squad has been reconvened under the chairmanship of Dr.Sandeep Shrivastava, Dean, JNMC in the month of June, 2015. The chairman in his address to the honorable members shall highlight the salient features of the recommendations and binding regulations of Medical Council of India and stress the need to take all necessary precautions and preventive measures so that no untoward incidence directly or indirectly amounting to ragging occurs in the campus. He shall further sensitize the faculty members and heads of departments to be vigilant in this direction.
2. **Sensitization of the Senior Students:** In order to sensitize the senior students they will be addressed by the Dean, Jawaharlal Nehru medical college in phase wise manner and to bring to their notice the relevant statutory provisions and anti-disciplinary measures which can be taken against those who are found to perpetrate, abate, assist or get involved in any sort of physical or mental harassment which also now comes under the purview of the definition of ragging.
3. **Undertaking from Students:** As per binding regulations referred above, an undertaking about non-indulgence in ragging, will be obtained from every student which is duly countersigned by their parents. The institute had taken measures in this direction and the procedure of obtaining such undertaking will be completed by 31st Oct of , 2017
4. **Certificate** of good character from the head of the earlier institution will obtained at the time of counseling from the fresher's of First MBBS
5. **Anti-Ragging Committee & Squad:** At the level of institute an Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad have been constituted as per directives of the Medical Council of India, New Delhi. The committees have been constituted comprising of members of faculty along with representatives of Police, Media and Non-Government Organization and their composition is as under:

Punishable ingredients of Ragging:- •

Abetment to ragging;

- Criminal conspiracy to rag;
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;
- Public nuisance created during ragging;
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- Wrongful restraint;
- Wrongful confinement;
- Use of criminal force;
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences;
- Extortion;
- Criminal trespass;
- Offences against property;
- Criminal intimidation;

- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s);
- Physical or psychological humiliation.
