Rotary International is a non-political service organization whose stated purpose is to bring together business and professional leaders in order to provide philanthropical services and to advance goodwill and peace around the world.

After identifying the coherence in the ideologies of Rotary and DMIMS, an agreement was established and the two organizations organize various activities and events together for providing services to the underprivileged.

<u>DATA GATHERING:</u> The joint venture with Rotary is supported by the Students and Faculty volunteers who are spread-out among various villages and remote tribal areas and identify the need for the Health and Wellbeing (SDG 3) of the underprivileged and collect the data. Based on the data collected, necessary action is taken after identifying the areas as under:

Cervical Cancer Awareness Camps: Various camps are organized for cervical cancer awareness across the country.



Mammography Bus: This bus goes from village to village where the team not only spreads awareness about breast cancer but also performs on-the-go mammographies. The diagnosed patients are referred back to AVBRH for further treatment.



Milk Banks: Milk Banks complying with the international standards are run which take care of the infants in need of breast-milk and also spread awareness about the importance of breast-feeding.



Free Milk Bank: Comprehensive Lactation Management Center in DMIMS (SU)

Ventilators: During a time when the entire world was facing the COVID crisis, ventilators proved to be life-savers. Rotary International provided two ventilators to AVBRH as part of the partnership with DMIMS.

Oxygen Pipelines: Rotary International has recently provided financial support for integrated Oxygen pipelines meant for distribution of Oxygen from the plant.


