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3.3.2. Health Outreach Programmes/Initiatives

DMIMS(DU), by virtue of its establishment, understands and delivers through various service initiatives towards its commitment to Local Community in particular and the Nation in general.

Towards the above, various Health Outreach Programs / Initiatives have been conducted through Medical Assistance rendered to the less privileged especially in the remote areas where no medical facilities were available.

By its sheer location, DMIMS(DU) has taken special initiatives to render medical support and services to the Tribals in the Hills in and around Wardha, the location in which DMIMS is located. Innumerable Tribals and less privileged are benefited out of this initiative.

Also, among the Local Community special Medical Assistance Programs are conducted to extend the Medical Services and Assistance to the less privileged especially the elderly in the locality. Furthermore, DMIMS(DU) provides expertise and services across the spectrum, ranging from urban, peri urban, slum, rural to tribal areas through camps, specialist visits, and urban and rural health training centers. 54 villages have been adopted under the village adoption scheme of DMIMS(DU) -Datta Sagar Aapulki Arogya Yojana for the purposes of health and hygiene awareness, preventive and curative measures services. The undergraduate students are oriented towards community needs (comprehensive health care) and health care by taking care of one family per student during their entire period of training.
