Systematically tracking women application, acceptance, entry and completion rate in the University.

At DMIMS a robust admission process is in place that starts right from identifying the prospective students, especially women, which can be seen from the high rate of admission of women students in the University.

Apart from this, a special tracking system is in place for the follow-up of the women prospective candidates which is apparent from the high percentage of women applicants and admissions in almost all programs, which is made possible by the personal connection established by call centres and counsellors dedicated for the admissions.

In order to interest more girl candidates for seeking admission and enrolling into higher educational streams, admissions committee officials visit various schools, mainly girls' schools and provide the following services:

- 1. Lecture series on women empowerment through higher education.
- 2. Employment opportunities.
- 3. Programmes and courses available at DMISMS(DU).
- 4. Special scholarships available for girl students.
